Activities

Vitbergsbadet Start the summer mornings with a warm dip in the pool. The excellent, heated Vitbergsbadet swimming complex right next to the camping area offers swimming for all tastes, ages and degrees of boldness. A wave machine, water slide, children's pool, hot water- and bubble pool.

The dinner menu, which is available from 18:00 to 22:00, includes marine fish. The restaurant is fully licenced, and of course musical entertainment is presented several times during the summer.

For body and soul In five minutes you can walk to Eddahallen. This modern swimming and fitness facility has eight different theme pools, a relaxation section, spa, sauna and gym. Unwind in a relaxing environment and let the rest of the family jump, climb and splash among the waves.

The Mini Club Every day from 15 to 17 during the peak season, we arrange activities in the Mini Club for children of all ages, such as an Indian trail, story times, theatre and pony rides. The current week's schedule is posted on the notice boards and on our website.

Exercise, sports and adventure Dash off or jog around on the camp's jogging track. If there is more spring in your step, there is always the tennis arena and Kombihallen, with its climbing wall, track and field and arm wrestling. And if you like skateboarding, you can try out the first stage of the new skate park this summer. It is located in the Folkpark area and will be completely finished in 2012. Equally close at hand is Norrvalla, the sports arena with tailor-made offerings year-round for clubs and teams in training.

The Service Pool At the Service Pool you can hire disc golf, mini golf, cycles and pedal cars. Free loan of balls, boccia, party games and more. There's also a minigolf course and sale of ice cream, kiosk items, slush, warm snacks, coffee and cakes. New this year is letting of skates for the new synthetic ice at Ungdomshallen in the Skellefteå Kraft Arena. We have also purchased Segways for letting – a novelty that has to be tried! The Service Pool is open every day during the peak season 10:30-23:00.

Entertainment and shopping In both summer and winter there are golden opportunities to satisfy your desires. Strolling among shops is best done in the city centre and at the Handelsplats Norr shopping centre. You will eat well at Vitbergsbadet Restaurant or at some of the city's many restaurants. In summer dances take place every Thursday at Folkparken, and on Sundays the clear choice is shopping at the flea market for all you are worth!

Winter – a time for training, laughter and play Illuminated ski trails, family-friendly slalom slopes and audacious fun park are a sample of what you will find in the camping area. On the other side of the Vitberget mountain, or rather inside it, nestles Boda Borg with its specially furnished rooms for challenges, games and competitions. Of course, in addition you can skate. Just don't forget your helmet when you step onto the rink!

Skellefteå Kraft Arena The home arena for the Skellefteå AIK hockey team. The arena is also the venue for some of the municipality's largest events. Here you will find box seats, conference spaces, a restaurant and a sports bar. The arena also houses Kombihallen, with track and field, climbing facilities, an ice rink for young people and a curling rink.

Norway Day, 8/7 This is the day when our Norwegian guests should feel even more appreciated, but obviously it is also a pleasant occasion for our other guests and for Skellefteå residents. Many shops and galleries have special offers and activities. During the day and evening we at Skellefteå Camping will also

celebrate a Norway Day of our very own with fashion shows and fun activities for young and old. This year motor vehicle inspections will be on site so you can check your caravan's LPG. At Byske Havsbad celebrations will already be under way on the evening of 7/7 with fashion shows and other attractions.

9-hole disc golf course Challenge the whole family in an exciting and unusual activity. Disc golf can be played by people of all ages and provides an opportunity to experience nature.

Camping Day 20/7 A fast-paced day full of surprises, contests, fashion shows and fun for people of all ages. Look for employees who might be dressed up as characters like Pippi Longstocking, pirates and bandits or perhaps a troll.

Summer events

In and around Skellefteå, major, minor and multitudinous events take place during the summer. Here is a small selection of those titbits that you as a guest of the camping area are welcome to enjoy. From well-attended summer theatre and jubilant music festivals to one of the largest city festivals Norrland has to offer.

City Festival, 29/6-3/7 The City Festival in Skellefteå is one of Norrland's largest summer events, which attracts about 90,000-100,000 visitors a year during the five days the festival continues. This summer the festival's main act is multiple Grammy Award winner Robyn.

Trästock ("Woodstock") Festival, 21-23/7 One of Sweden's most popular music festivals celebrates its 20th anniversary this summer. As usual visitors face a daunting programme with a total of about 100 acts. Everything from local bands to musical greats are intermixed with all manner of cultural expression – and admission is still free!

Food Festival, 25-28/8 A food-oriented folk festival focusing on regional cuisine. For four days an abundance of culinary experiences are served up. Elegant, robust, exotic, traditional...there's something here for every palate.

Burträsksvängen Music Festival July 6–8

Folk Music Festival July 14–16 Burträsksvängen is one of the country's most popular and one of northern Sweden's most attended music events. Burträsksvängen now takes place on two weekends.

Skellefteå Air Show, 20/8 Once again the sky provides a backdrop for neck-wrenching acrobatics and reckless manoeuvres when the Skellefteå Air Show is in charge of the event.

Gold Town Drag Race, 15–17/7 An event that attracts both great public interest and an impressive line-up. The competition takes place on the third day and the constantly recurring question is: Who is really fastest over a distance of 402 metres?

Summer Theatre – *Det susar i säven* (“The Wind in the Willows”), 18/6–17/7
The Västerbotten Theatre presents a summer adventure at Nordanå, by the river and the park’s beautiful waters. This is a real classic that has captivated generations with suspense and a great deal of humour.

Government owned liquor shop You will find one liquor shop (Systembolag) at Solbacken and one at CityKompaniet in the city centre.

Comfort & Order

SCR's established rules apply here. There is a notice on the board at Reception. The campsite employees are empowered to send away guests who fail to follow these rules.

Entrance and exit Sites for caravans/motorhomes/tents are intended for registered guests with a caravan and one car. Both tents and caravans/motor homes should maintain a distance of at least 4 metres from one another. Any visitors should be referred to the guest parking area outside the camping area.

Motor traffic

Motor traffic is permitted at walking pace when entering and leaving. Mopeds are to be pushed within the camping area.

Quiet in the campground

Quiet is mandatory 23:00 – 06:00. During this period all motor traffic is prohibited within the camping area.

Night guards

Night guards watch the area between 10 pm and 6 am from June 20 to August 7. If you need to call the security guard, go to Reception and lift the telephone receiver. You'll then be connected directly with the security guard. Otherwise ring 070-348 71 97. If you lift the receiver at other times of the year, you will be connected directly with SOS.

Firecrackers

Fireworks and firecrackers are forbidden within the camping area.

Dogs

Dogs must be kept on a lead within the camping area and relieved outside the site.

Smoking

Naturally all of our buildings are smoke-free.

Barbecues

Wood barbecues are allowed at designated places. Barbecues using gas or charcoal are permitted with devices on legs or other supports. Charcoal barrels are located at the environment stations.

The environment

We at Skellefteå Camping look after the environment, and it is natural for us to be actively engaged in the environment. At our environment stations we sort out clear and green glass, paper, cardboard, plastic, batteries and metal. Swedish PET bottles can be redeemed in the shop.

Note that we require that enclosed systems/containers be used for waste water from caravans and campervans.
